Age: 47

From: York



New Career: Physiotherapist

Career Development: Annabelle became interested in physiotherapy when she needed treatment for injuries sustained as a jockey. With help from JETS and support from the IJF, she gained a Human Biology A level enabling her then to do a degree, qualifying in 2011. Since then she has progressed through the NHS, overcoming her own disability and multiple surgeries, to become a musculoskeletal physio for South Tees NHS Trust. She recently gained a junior research award to complete a research project for Teesside University and she hopes with further qualification, that in the future she may use her experience as a jockey to help patients at Jack Berry House.

Since riding, Tony has built up his training and qualifications and has used his racing contacts to secure a good deal of work from within the racing industry. Tony now runs a successful business, taking on staff and expanding his management skills in order to grow the business.

Career Development: Niall consulted with JETS about different career options while still riding. He attended various media training days which, along with passion for

racing, his knowledge of race form and pedigree, inspired him to pursue a career in broadcasting and is now a regular presenter with Racing UK. In 2014, he also became a jockeys agent, with 9 jockeys on his books and speaks with trainers on a daily basis who value his in depth race knowledge and has achieved some big winners already with his jockeys. He also sits on a panel aiming to help regenerate Jump Racing in the North of England.

4. KYLIE MANSER

New Career: Racehorse retrainer

Career Development: Kylie first became interested in retraining and rehoming racehorses when she was still riding and due to her background in non racing riding disciplines it was a good way to keep in contact with the racing world and put something back into it. She got her LGV and trailer driver licences to help her with the business which has grown from retraining and rehoming around 15 horses in her first year to around 60 a year now. She now owns a yard with purpose built arena, level turnout, up to 12 stables, a horse treadmill and solarium. With her extensive network of contacts, she is one of 8 retrainers listed on the Retraining of Racehorses (RoR) website and her horses have gone onto successful careers in a range of disciplines.

JETS also helped him gain a sales role with Red Mills prior to that. Michael has applied skills he acquired in racing managing teams, building relationships and communicating with owners and trainers in his new career. He is now developing new technology which has seen him travel worldwide, developing the business internationally and set up agents abroad.

in Northamptonshire. He feels very rewarded that he's been able to use his sporting background in his new career and inspire young people in sport.
